Alaska and Hawaii, Non-Self-Governing Territories¹, issue diplomatic protests against the unilateral adoption of General Assembly resolution 1469 of 12 December 1959. This created the Alaska apartheid regime – the so-called 49th state of the United States of America, after the Supreme Court of the United States of America designated it for the “white race” [Tee-Hit-Ton v USA (348 US 272, 1955, footnote 18)]. The United Nations created the apartheid regime state of Alaska by refusing to implement General Assembly resolutions as was fully applied to other Non-Self-Governing Territories. General Assembly resolution 1469 must be annulled.

The Mechanism on the Right to Development and the Truth and Reconciliation Special Rapporteur have complete information that needs specific recommendations to address Alaska and Hawaii and other situations.

The situation in Jammu and Kashmir needs direct attention by the Council.

IHRAAM lauds China for its resolution on the Legacy of Colonialism and calls upon the European Union, the USA and the UK and its Western allies not to obstruct the scope of the right of colonial countries and peoples with double standards in the consultation process.

The Unilateral and Coercive Measures resolution needs specific text for the rights of all peoples, including Indigenous Peoples in the resolution.
